**vision = mental sight produced thru
a revelation**

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no
revelation, the people cast off
restraint; But happy is he who keeps
the law. (NASB).

Proverbs 29: 18 Where there is
no vision, the people perish: but
he that keepeth the law, happy
is he. (KJV).

*Proverbs 29:18 If people can't see
what God is doing, they stumble
all over themselves; But when
they attend to what he reveals,
they are most blessed. (MSG).*

Clean


- Cleaning up the mess is usually just shuffling things around to call it clean. It looks good but it's permanent.

Declutter

- De = denotes removal or separation; taking away.
- Clutter = is a lot of disorganized stuff in one place
- To declutter is to remove unnecessary items
