



Poverty

- **A belief that produces a state of mind that there are not enough resources available**
- **Believe**
- **There aren't enough resources available to you**
- **That others have what you need**
- **That you can't get own your own what you need**
- **Way of Life**
- **You will do things out of character to get your needs met**

How to Break the Poverty Mentality

- **Root:** Destroy the root of poverty in your life
- **Relationships:** Connect to the proper relationships to break the cycle of poverty
- **Rules:** Uncover the hidden rules of poverty that you are living by
- **Resources:** Get the right resources in your life

Wealth

- **Spirit/Heart that leads to a mentality, which produces a way of Life**
- **Believe**
- **I have adequate access to resources I need to succeed**
- **"there's more where this came from"**
- **Way of Life**
- **Live open handed with people, money, opportunities.....**
- **Works and produces fruit**
