



Today we are going to challenge our hope. There are two types of hope. Hope that will work and hope that won't!!

- **Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.**
 - **Faith is the blueprint for your hope**
 - **It takes faith to produce hope**
 - **Faith is action based on a plan that brings hope into reality**
 - **Hope must be valid in order for it to produce. If your hope is faulty you are setting yourself up for failure. You will blame your faith when in reality faith can't make something work that won't work**

REBUILDING HOPE!


Faith that is needed to rebuild your hope because life has hit you and you don't have hope anymore.

Romans 5:3 And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance; 4 and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope; 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Can't Stop Won't Stop Hope!

Hope against hope = In the face of a strong NO and resistance you still keep pushing because of a promise....

Romans 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. 19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb: 20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; 21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. 22 And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness.





Chosen Hope!

You pick a promise because of your situation and stand on it.

1 John 5:14 This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15 And if we know that He hears us in Whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

Proverbs 23:18 Surely there is a future, And your hope will not be cut off.
